True an... of mercy is Edna E. Roach, of the army nurse corps, for she is now a flight nurse seeing action in the European theater of operation. It is her job to fly with the wounded from one hospital to another, as a member of a medical air evacuation transport squadron. Recently she was assigned to the Ninth troop carrier command in the European theater. On her hospital plane, the Quincey nurse cares for from between 20 to 24 patients on flights.

This interesting news about Lieutenant Roach has been released from the public relations office of the Ninth air force. However, friends in Quincy, including former associates of St. Mary hospital hear from her from time to time.

Lieutenant Roach is a graduate of the St. Mary hospital school of nursing. For a time she was in the surgical department of the hospital and later did general duty nursing for the U. S. Veterans administration at Indianapolis. After enlisting, she returned to Quincy and while awaiting her call she was assigned to the nursing arts instructor at St. Mary.

Lieutenant Roach went to Bend, Ore. for her early army training and was graduated in January, 1944, from the army air force school of air evacuation at Bowman field, Ky. The school gives the nurses a most intensive course including parachute training.

Lieutenant Roach is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. M. H. Roach of Elona. She is a most attractive and capable young person and has been held in high esteem by her friends and associates here.

The Ninth air force, to which her squadron has been assigned since its arrival in the European theater of operations, fought through the North African and Mediterranean campaigns from El Alamein to the beachheads of Italy and is now U. S. component of the allied expeditionary air force. Troop carrier units have been active since the start of the war in glider and parachute operations, in aerial supply of front line troops and in the air evacuation of sick and wounded military personnel.
